



Nine days of prayer on behalf of the suffering souls in Purgatory



INTRODUCTION Why We Pray

The Church has always professed the need to pray for the holy souls in Purgatory. Specifically, *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* reminds us of our duty as members of "The Church Militant" to pray for "The Church Suffering". The Church Suffering includes, "*All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation*". As such, "*…after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven*". (CCC 1030)

Our prayers therefore, are a form of compassion for those souls who may then be delivered into heaven sooner. They are unable to prayerfully help themselves. But rather, have a complete reliance on the prayers and works of the saints ("The Church Triumphant") and us.

And these prayers are true spiritual offerings to God. Through our prayerful assistance we may reduce the suffering of those in Purgatory and expedite them into the Beatific Vision and the peace of Paradise. In the Second Book of Maccabees, we come to know the efficaciousness of such prayers. Judas Maccabeus professing true belief in the Resurrection of the dead, implored his people to pray for their deceased companions. "In doing this, he acted in a very excellent and noble way, inasmuch as he had the resurrection in mind; for if he were not expecting the fallen to rise again, it would have been superfluous and foolish to pray for the dead... Thus he made atonement for the dead that they might be absolved from their sin." (2 Maccabees 12:43-44)

In light of these scriptural lessons, the Church unhesitatingly prompts us, "Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them." (CCC 1032)







DAY ONE

St. Michael the Archangel

St. Michael the Archangel, I come before you first as I initiate my novena for the holy souls in Purgatory.
