- Council #14224 will acknowledge winners in each grade with cash prize and certificate.
- Council level winners will participate in the Massachusetts Council Essay Contest level for further prizes.

- **35 Points:** Content How thoroughly is the topic examined?
- 30 Points: Grammar How well is the essay written with respect to sentence and paragraph construction?
- **35 Points:** Style Does the essay show creativity, imagination and development of the topic in a logical and compelling style?
